

## ILC & FDSV Disability Grant

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### Why are we issuing this Grant?

The objective of this EOI is comprised of two components; the first focuses on individuals and organisations working in primary health care settings and aims to build their capacity to support people with disabilities.

The second component focuses on primary health care organisations only\* and aims to build their capacity to support people with disabilities who are at risk of or experiencing FDSV. Both components are outlined below in more detail in the grant guidelines.

#### How will this funding be divided?

Organisations can apply for up to \$25,000 while individual health workers can apply for up to \$5,000 to support and undertake their activities.

*(Individual grant applications are only available under the first funding opportunity outlined in the grant guidelines).*

#### Who can apply?

Registrations are invited from suitably qualified disability, primary health care or training providers interested in delivering or undertaking capacity building activities to support people with disabilities and/or support people with disabilities who are at risk of or experiencing FDSV.

#### Could you please provide clarification between the two streams?

Grant funding available under component 2 is for organisational level only; individual health worker applications are not considered under this funding opportunity.

#### Can we continue to provide the current service or only new activities proposed?

This funding is only for new activities proposed and cannot be utilized for current services/ activities which are funded through other funding avenues.
